



Information for Parents

- SNAP discos are organised by Princes Hall (Rushmoor Borough Council) in conjunction with Hampshire Constabulary.
- SNAP stands for Say No And Phone.
- Tickets are only available in advance and cannot be purchased on the door. The Box Office closes at 5.30pm on the day of SNAP, after this point tickets cannot be purchased.
- There is a Police presence at each SNAP disco's, both before and during the night.
- As well as Princes Hall Stewards there are additional security staff.
- Entrance to SNAP discos are from the side of the building, with a separate door for boys and girls. The doors open at 7.00pm.
- All children are searched as they enter the building for any dangerous / hazardous / inappropriate items.
 - I.E. Chunky Jewellery, hairspray, chewing gum, etc.
 - Any items seized will be bagged and kept secure in the cloak room until the end of the evening when they can be collected.
- There is a strict age policy at SNAP disco's (11- 16's), if you are worried about your child being denied entry due to their appearance, they can bring along a copy of their birth certificate or similar Identification.
- Children who need to collect tickets must make their way to the Box Office, under the main stairs before queuing for entry at the side of the building. When collecting tickets we simply ask them to confirm their surname and first name, which you would have been asked for when booking the tickets.
- Children with tickets can proceed directly to the main entrances at the side of the building.
- A free of charge cloakroom is provided, but we are unable to accept; bags, hats, shoes, or anything valuable. Please take this into account before you leave, as your child will have to keep hold of these sorts of items throughout the evening.
- Once your child has entered the building they will not be allowed to leave un-escorted, if you do wish to collect your child early then you need to arrange to meet at the main entrance doors, a member of the security staff will only allow your child to leave if you are there.
- There is a Coffee Shop, which sells ice creams (£1.60) and soft drinks, all priced at £1.20 and water priced at £1.00. However we would suggest that your child does not bring along a lot of money.
- SNAP ends at 11.00pm. Please arrange to meet your child on the front steps of the building.
